Sponsored by the Friends of the Coralville Public Library, the Teen Service Award is an annual \$1,000 award that recognizes an outstanding Coralville Public Library teen volunteer. To be considered for this award, students must:

- be a senior in high school
- have logged 50 or more total volunteer hours for the Coralville Public Library
- complete the enclosed application (feel free to include an extra sheet of paper if your responses require more space than was provided)

Deadline: February 1

A committee of Friends of the Coralville Public Library board members will review the applications and select a recipient. [Disclaimer: The Friends board may choose not to award the Teen Service Award if they feel there are no qualified applicants.

The recipient will be notified prior to the Friends of the Coralville Public Library's annual meeting (usually held sometime in late April). The award will be presented at the Friends of the Coralville Public Library's annual meeting.
