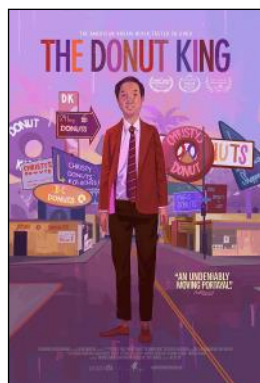
Reflect on Coralville's history and future! This event features displays and activities from 12:00 - 2:30 pm to mark Coralville's history, development, and future.
