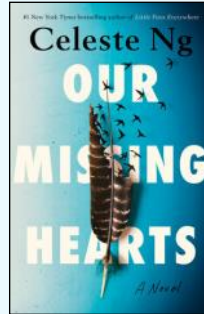
## **THE CUCKOO'S CALLING**
