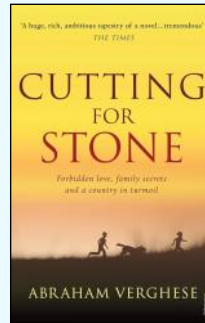
## It's a **Mystery!** Book Group

## Library Mission Statement

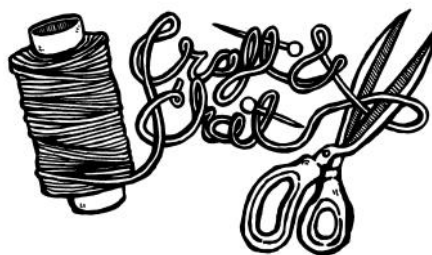
