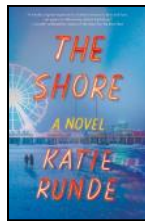

Join us for an evening of Live Storytelling with the theme of comfort food sponsored by the Coralville Public Library and held at the Coralville Center for the Performing Arts.

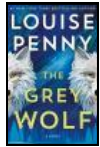
Prepare a five-minute story to share about comfort food, or just sit back and enjoy the show!

This **free** event will be hosted by Nick Westergaard, director of UI's Story Lab. Refreshments, including alcoholic beverages, will be available for purchase.

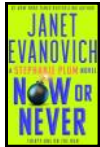
