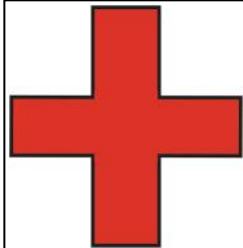

12:00 - 3:00 PM

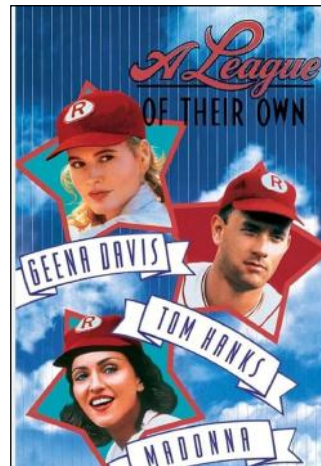
