


- ____ Occasionally run your finger under the words you read and point out words or names.
- ____ Read a rhyming picture book.
- ____ Complete a **Search & Find** activity; ask at the Children's Desk.
- ____ Check out a children's magazine and read it together.
- ____ Write numbers on the sidewalk with chalk. Say them as you step on them.
- ____ Read an informational book; many are just right for this age.
- ____ Pretend to be in a boat and sing "Row, Row, Row Your Boat."
- ____ Use a favorite toy to explore spatial concepts like on/off, above/below, up/down, behind/in front, etc.
- ____ Go on a scavenger hunt or play "I Spy" for objects starting with a specific letter.
- ____ Read a book about summer. Talk about seasons/months of the year.
- ____ Use blocks to build a tower; count the blocks as you stack them.
- ____ Squish and mold playdough to help strengthen fingers for writing.
- ____ Choose a book to read from the **LEVEL UP** display at the library.
